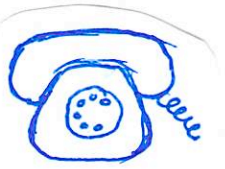


The Defining Moves International Communication Cheat Sheet

THE LANDLUBBERS

If you prefer a landline..

Ask your service provider about reduced rate international packages And / Or
Try Rebtel (www.rebtel.com). It requires a one-time online set-up, but saves up to 98% on call costs..



THE DESK JOCKEYS

If you have a high speed internet connection and a PC / Mac / laptop / tablet with a microphone / webcam and speakers..



Try Skype.com for calls to other Skype users, free video calls and cheap calls to landlines worldwide. Great value subscriptions available, BUT it's expensive to call mobiles / cellphones, calls are frequently dropped and their customer service is horrible..

THE OLD SCHOOL

Got a cellphone, but no data?

It's Rebtel again. Sign up online, load your contacts, save the new numbers to your phone and voila! International mobile calling at local rates. (and they offer a free trial. - what more could you ask?)
